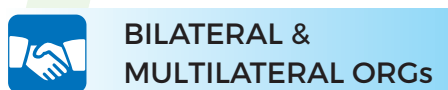
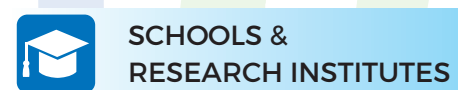
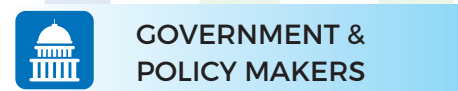

Evidence includes photos, videos, slide presentations, surveys, pre-and post-intervention data and its analysis (quantitative, anecdotal and qualitative) as in action research.

AWARDS: All GETI Fellows with evidence posted in their e-portfolio will automatically qualify for the Innovator Awards at the next Ed Leadership Conference. Those with documentary evidence of their pre-existing innovative work may also apply for this year's GETI Education Innovator Awards.
